Winter conditions can also make scheduling a day trip difficult—finding that perfect day—light winds, minimum swell and shorter days can easily dissuade sport fishers. But Fear Not! SIR Captain Ed Bush of the Miss Molly has the know-how to find the fish. If you are interested in fishing this winter season for sanddabs, petrale Sole, flounder or other ground fish, have a chat with Captain Ed at any of our monthly meeting. For us landlubbers who have "issues" (motion sickness) with boat fishing- This is the perfect time of year to get out to local beaches on the Monterey Bay and fish for Surf Perch!
