Bryan Stow, a San Francisco Giants fan and Scotts Valley paramedic, was viciously attacked in the Los Angeles Dodgers parking lot in 2011. He has since then undergone a long recovery process. He will tell us about that and how he has repurposed his life to help stop bullying.

OUR BIG SIR GREG HORNE SEZ:



You'll have noticed the construction activity in what used to be the upper parking lot at the Elks Lodge. The Santa Cruz Memory Care facility, which will provide housing and long-term care for people with Alzheimer's, is being built on land leased from the Elks organization. As well as providing a valuable and long-awaited resource for the community, this

project will generate much-needed funding for Elks Lodge 824, and help to ensure its financial well-being for years to come.

The reduction in parking capacity is, however, creating an occasional challenge for Lodge members, and for groups like us who use the facility. Notices are clearly posted to inform contractor personnel that they are not to park on the premises, but instead, should park offsite after dropping off tools and supplies. Lodge management is working hard to enforce this restriction, but it is taking time to get the message across to all the contractors. A sparsely-populated lot on some days does not mean that the restriction is unnecessary! We observed a fair number of contractor vehicles parked in the Elks lot in advance of our July meeting, and I suspect that this may have created problems for some of our members and possibly contributed to our lower-than-expected turnout.

I want to make sure that no member is ever prevented or discouraged from attending the SIR meeting due to parking issues. We'll
