The BEC has approved a necessary price increase for our monthly lunch. Mickey is an excellent chef and the meals are always different. But food costs have gone up and Mickey has had to increase the price of lunch from \$14.50 to \$16.00. Now, you figure in that includes tax and tip. You can't get a lunch like we do at any restaurant for that amount. The Elks Lodge charges \$2 per person for the use of the facility. The other \$2 helps cover the cost of the SIR insurance that we are charged. The balance of \$1.40 helps pay for items like the Speaker's lunch, the small gift we give the speaker and the Birthday winner's lunch. It also applies to cover any shortfall we have at the bar if we don't hit that \$140 minimum. Please don't let this cost increase keep you from attending our meetings.
