FISHING- For 2022, the seasons are as follows:

Jan. to Mar 31– only legal catch are sole, sand dabs, halibut and crab. April 1– Rock Cod season opens. April 4– King Salmon season opens. SIRs who fished last year know what to expect. New participants can call me to get on the list for trips (408-997-1836).

With Monterey Bay fishing, everything depends on the weather– often times short notice is all that can be provided. I watch the weather every day and might go any day of the week based on current conditions. It is important that new guys are not subject to sea sickness and are flexible time-wise. Maximum load on my boat is myself + three.

I suggest carpooling whenever possible. Parking is available for one vehicle, I have one extra fee parking pass that I will give to the driver.

We normally leave the dock just after sunrise and fish until noon or so. Bring your own lunch, I provide needed rods, reels, gear and bait. You can bring your own gear if you have it. I will clean the fish we catch.

Those who plan to participate need to get your 2022 license. Bayside Marine carries both day and yearly licenses.

The White House unfurled <u>covidtests.gov</u> a website where Americans can order up to four free rapid antigen COVID-19 tests per household at no charge.

The tests will be delivered by the U.S. Postal Service to "valid residential addresses" and are expected to arrive at most locations by late January.
