WHAT JUST HAPPENED? WHAT MIGHT COME NEXT?

Over the past few weeks, news coverage of the pandemic in the United States has been pessimistic, with suggestions that a second closure of the economy due to rising infection rates may be needed. And yet, there is a counterpoint. The counterpoint, by a portion of the medical fraternity, makes an interesting, statistically based argument that current lockdown measures are an overreaction, the US is on the cusp of achieving "herd immunity" allowing us an opportunity to reach something close to prepandemic "normal" without waiting for vaccines.

Which theory do I think is right. I don't know. I share this with you as the answer falls under two important values; **sharing Knowledge and Humility.** Sharing knowledge is one way we can, over time, answer these questions, and from our humility we recognize that while there are many persuasive opinions, just because we agree with one does not mean we don't need to take into consideration the other side.

This leads to the topic of **masks.** To some this may be a political statement; the decision about wearing a mask is not similar to the decision about wearing a bicycle or motorcycle helmet. The latter is to protect the wearer; the mask does not protect the wearer-a mask protects everyone you come in contact with. Even if you believe that we have reached herd immunity. **Humility** is taking actions that respect the welfare of others who may not share your opinion. Until we clearly have the answer, please wear a mask; don't leave home without it.

Going forward with Branch 23, I congratulate all who attended our mid- month ZOOM meeting and salute our new ZOOM Team, chaired by Lam Nguyen, in continuing to improve our ZOOM capabilities as well as our digital message system to our membership.

The State SIR will meet on August 19 for an annual meeting, at which time new officers will be voted on. Concurrently, Branch 23 will be presenting a new slate of BEC and Directors for member approval during August.

The State SIR has just announced that they have secured a Marketing firm to assist in creating a "new" public image of SIR and target potential new members with the creation of a new outreach plan. Here is the policy statement approved by SIR State for our Hiking Group Restart Distancing

Exercising normal hiking etiquette automatically creates a safe social distance of at least six feet or more. Step aside and turn your head away to allow oncoming hikers pass from either direction. When stepping aside, safely create as much distance as possible from oncoming hikers.

Face Masks

Preferably, hikers should wear a face mask at all times. If a face mask restricts your breathing, keep draped under your chin apply your face mask when oncoming hikers are passing from either direction.

Government Agencies

Most hiking trails areas are now open. Government agencies recognize hiking as one of the safer outdoor activities. Someone from our group will contact the government agency responsible for a specific trail to verify its opening.
