The Memorial Day parade features marching bands, active duty military personnel, and veterans from conflicts ranging from World War II to Iraq. The parade is led by the 191st Army Band from the Main Post Parade Ground to the San Francisco National Cemetery. Parade begins at the great lawn [parade ground] 10:30 with ceremonies in the San Francisco National Cemetery at the cenotaph at 11:00. Tours of the cemetery follow.
