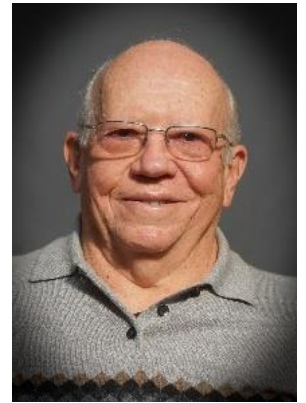
## PHOTOGRAPHY

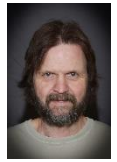

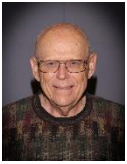

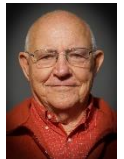
