There are 13 technical articles ranging from the use of smart phone GPS data to track the spread of COVID-19 to the cost of owning a Tesla Model 3. - **9. Military Jet Fighters Will Be Replaced By Drones** In February, at the Air Warfare Symposium, Elon Musk said he believes "drone warfare will define future combat while traditional manned fighter jets will fade in importance. Artificial Intelligence (AI) has the potential to be the most transformative technology of the near future." Mr. Musk also stated that "Designing a rocket is trivial". Your bulletin editor has done both of these (fighter jets and designing rockets) and was not impressed. A full report of Mr. Musk's comments is in the Air Force Magazine article at the link.
- 13. What Does It Cost To Own A Tesla Model 3? The owner of a Tesla Model 3, an all-electric four door sedan, comments in a web post about his total two year cost of driving his Tesla a total of 24,000 miles. "I can only answer to what mine has cost me" he states and goes on to describe his personal cost over the two year period. The cost was \$95. You should keep in mind that he plugged it in every day to his company's charging station, and when he did charge it at home there was no cost because he has solar panels and there will be no home electricity charge for the next ten years!
