



Changes in the serving of our luncheons.


This past year we experimented with three caterers and have been disappointed in the results with all three. It has become apparent we cannot afford a full service caterer for that amount and expect a top quality meal. Therefore, we will be having a meal delivered but we will have to provide some of the tasks which were formerly provided by a full service caterer. We will provide table coverings, plates, cups, and utensils (all disposable). A packaged table cover will be placed on each table and the members sitting at that table will be responsible for spreading it on the table. This is so that we will not waste a table covering on am unused table.

At the end of the luncheon place all plates and utensils in the middle of the table covering, roll everything in the cover and place it in the trash.

Our meals will be provided by Kerri at "That Dam Place" Restaurant. Kerri comes highly recommended (many of our members are frequent customers) and I am confident our membership will enjoy the quality of the meals provided by the restaurant.

I will do my best to work out any kinks prior to the January luncheon. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated. We have instituted another policy to reduce the cost of our luncheons. In the past Bob's callers would ask for a yes or no to attend the luncheon. Members who said yes but failed to show cost the branch the amount of the lunch. Several lunches cost the branch anywhere from \$50 to a \$100. Effective this year a member who does not show will be charged for that lunch. Obviously, there are valid reasons which will be taken into consideration.
