

RECRUITMENT SPONSORSHIP REWARDS

Branch-54 members are encouraged to invite visitors to our monthly luncheons as often as possible for the purpose of increasing branch membership. To motivate our members in becoming more active toward the attainment of this goal, the following procedure is now in effect.

When an inductee has been formally introduced and presented with a SIR membership packet before the general membership assembly, the sponsor will be rewarded for his recruitment efforts by presentation of a Certificate of Achievement by the Big SIR, or designee.

The rewarded sponsor may then present the certificate to the branch Treasurer in exchange for a well-earned free meal. And even though it is possible for a sponsor to recruit several inductees in any given year, he will be rewarded each time this goal is achieved.

Although always encouraged to recruit former or current SIR's from other branches, a sponsorship award does not apply under this circumstance.
