George grew up in Aberdeen, Washington and is one of 10 children, all of whom are still alive. He graduated from Western Washington University and began teaching in 1958. He did graduate work at U.C. Berkeley and San Jose State. He



taught History and Government in Washington for 6 years and then moved to California in 1964 to begin a career at Newark Unified School District.

He was a longtime volunteer for the homeless and found apartments for at least 100 families who were living in the streets. He has a passion for the poor.

He will lead a discussion on Gun Control and Racism. These subjects are in the news and need to be talked about in a rational matter. You are encouraged to ask questions and get things off your minds. These are emotional subjects and almost everyone has an opinion one way or another. The Bill Of Rights will be discussed as well as local laws and immigration as it pertains to the area. Remember to speak up or forever hold your peace. George is a member of Branch 59 and spoke a few months ago about his experiences in the Korean War. He said you were a tremendous crowd and thanks you for your good behavior.


