# WHAT'S HAPPENING? by Big Sir Rob Ingebretson



It has been brought to my attention that we have a problem that seems to be getting worse with each meeting. We are having more men coming to our monthly luncheon and not eating. # **Speaker Jon Ford**by Little Sir Larry Goodman



Jon Ford is a retired elementary school educator and administrator retiring in 2009 after 35 years. After retirement he spent one year as a substitute for Fremont Unified School Districet. However, his real love is wine and wine making.

For his presentation he will focus on recent studies about a person's wine palate and how they can determine why they buy and drink

certain wines. Jon likes to be able to have the participants take a very short, multiple-choice test to determine their style of palate and relate their results with the overall ranking system that tells them the styles of wines they would probably prefer.

Ford has worked for Concannon Vineyards as a tasting room employee for 17 years. Concannon sent him to 80 hours of training in Napa — with three master Sommeliers leading the training — as part of a major food and wine focus for major restaurants and wineries. It was at that time he became very focused on wine in general. Jon began making wine with three friends about 15 years ago and they produce about 80 cases of award winning wines of many varietals each year. Through Concannon he taught wine appreciation courses with three other employees.

He has started working part time for another winery in Livermore known as Bent Creek Vineyards. His enjoyment in working at wineries is being able to teach wine drinkers of any level to walk away from their tasting experience feeling that they know more about wine than when they first came in.

Jon and his wife moved to the Del Webb retirement community in Manteca three years ago and he founded a club known as "Wine 101" in 2011. For each class he makes a presentation about a specific grape variety and then the group samples the same varietal as it is paired with food. The initial class consisted of 20 participants and now have a cut-off for his classes at 101 participants with a waiting list. Winemakers/owners from wineries in Lodi and Livermore are invited to make presentations on their wineries, varietals, history, and techniques.




