SPEAKER SHARENE GONZALES By Little Sir Larry Goodman

Sharene Gonzales is a member of the Alameda County Water District's communications team. She assists with ACWD's communications program, community relations, social media, and strategic planning. Her role provides support to various departments within the District to inform and educate the public on water conservation, water supply



conditions, and infrastructure and construction projects – most notably ACWD's extensive Main Replacement and Seismic Upgrade Program.

She has more than seven years' experience working in the public sector. Prior to joining ACWD, Sharene worked for the City of Stockton's Municipal Utilities Department where she was responsible for the communication and outreach of the City's water, wastewater and storm water utilities. She also has experience working in both the non-profit and private sector.

Sharene graduated magna cum laude with a degree in Communications Studies with an emphasis in public relations from the University of the Pacific. She is a member of the California Association of Public Information Officials, received her conservation practitioner certificate from American Water Works Association California-Nevada Section, and is a graduate of the Fremont Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Fremont program.

The 2013-2014 period is the driest rain year on record, the ACWD seriously impacts water supply conditions. California is experiencing one of the worst droughts in recorded history and much of the state and water utilities are facing water supply challenges. The presentation will cover current water supply conditions, impacts of reduced water supply, the financial impacts of the drought, and water conservation programs and incentives. Customers can learn what they can do to help conserve water as we move into the summer months when demands peak and it is more important than ever to conserve this resource.


