SPEAKER Rachel DiFranco By Little Sir Jim Ulam

Rachel DiFranco is Sustainability Coordinator for the City of Fremont, Rachel is responsible for implementing the City's Climate Action Plan goal of a 25% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by the year 2020.

Rachel is a Fremont native, having graduated from American High in 2001. She holds a BA in Global Studies from UC Santa



Barbara and a Dual MA in International Affairs and Natural Resources & Sustainable Development from American University in Washington, DC and the United Nations mandated University for Peace in Costa Rica. In her Master's thesis "Suburban Sustainability: Rethinking the Community of Fremont, CA," she used her hometown of Fremont as a case study to discuss the need for sustainable re-development of the suburbs to reduce dependence on the automobile as a necessary greenhouse gas reduction strategy.

Beginning in 2009, Rachel worked for non-profits throughout Northern California to provide energy efficiency and renewable energy outreach, education, and project development to residential, commercial, and municipal properties. In 2013, she returned to Fremont, California to become the City of Fremont's first Sustainability Coordinator, a role dedicated to overseeing the implementation of the City's Climate Action Plan by identifying and implementing opportunities for emission reductions and promoting energy efficiency efforts in both the City's municipal operations and in the community-at-large.


