He is a son of the founder of Kimber Farms which became the second largest employer in Fremont.

Soon after Art graduated from Washington High School, people started getting draft orders from the military to fight in WWII. Art decided to enlist in the Air Force before the orders came. Art learned to fly and spent two years and seven months fighting in the war. His squadron was stationed in Northern Italy and ran over 39 combat missions.

Sir Bob Benya is well known to all of us as Branch 59 song leader/historian. In recognition of Veterans Day these two Veterans will speak to us about their experience flying B-25 bombers. They will give different opinions about the operation of this venerable aircraft.




We will be entertained by Rudy Ramos and his acoustic guitar during


