### Jim's Thoughts by Big Sir Jim Ulam

There were plenty of branches around, and the men were carrying a big coil of rope, but the men just stood there watching as the poor woman and her children sank deeper and

deeper. The woman screamed and begged for assistance and the children wailed in fear, and the men just stood there.

Finally, with a last gasp of fear and agony, the woman and her children sank from sight, lost forever because men who watched, and were able to help, did nothing. As the quicksand bubbled and then became calm, the men looked at each other. One man spoke to his comrades and said "why didn't you save them?" Each man, in turn, looked at the others, and finally one said "I thought YOU were going to do it!"

Since I don't have a Little Sir, let me explain the moral to you. Sir Branch 59 is sinking in quicksand, and if everyone just stands around waiting for someone else to save it, we are going down like that poor woman and her children. Are you going to stand around and say "I thought YOU were going to save it?"

Why do I bring this up again? At the end of calendar year 2010, this branch had <u>229</u> active members, in 2011 membership fell to 204, then to 195 in 2012, then 179 In 2013, 163 in 2014, and <u>153</u> in 2015! That is a **33% drop in membership in six years!!** This branch truly IS sinking and we need lots of help to save it! SIR state officers have given us a plan to turn this trend around, and their goal for us is to **increase membership** by just one each year. Assuming we meet that goal, we will be back to our 2010 numbers in 76 years! If we can achieve a net increase of five new members a year we'll be there in 15 years.

Since I don't have a Little Sir, I have to ask you all again, are we just going to stand around looking at each other, waiting for the OTHER guy to step up?!






