June 2016 Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Big Sir Jim Ulam; the flag salute and roll call of officers and directors was conducted. Officers Present: Big Sir Jim Ulam, Assistant Treasurer Sir Arnold George, Secretary Sir Peter Angelides, and Assistant Secretary Sir Jerry Robertson

Officers Absent: Treasurer Sir Hugh Twomey Directors Present: Sir Nat Lord, Sir George Perry and Sir Al Weiner.

Directors Absent: Sir Jerry Sabo

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> Sir Arnold George reported that Branch finances are in good shape with a balance of \$3984.79 on June 16th; an increase of over \$200 from May.

Minutes of the April meeting and the Treasurer's report were accepted without change.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

<u>Birthdays</u>: Chairman Sammy Lum reported on May and June celebrants. Charles Wilkins is the oldest and Michael Lopez is the youngest.

Membership: Carl Nordling reported for Ron Brutvan (on vacation) that Jack Alt will become a new member at today's meeting. Jerry Ford will attend his second orientation. Two new guests today are Andrew Norris and Fred Barker. James Cunningham attended the April meeting, is still interested in SIR however can't make the June meeting. Amrik Johal has decided not to join SIR. Raymond Carlson #21 is going inactive. Wayne Adams is considering going inactive due to health concerns. Tom Federico has become active again.

Golf: Big Sir Jim Ulam, filling in for Bill Leake during his recovery, reported that the Golf activity has split into several groups playing at different times and locations. At the end of the BEC meeting Jim welcomed Bill back to his role as Chairman.

NEW BUSINESS

Big Sir Jim Ulam led off the discussion of Form 27 by commenting that we are doing great with 156 current members, more than our goal of 154. However, he emphasized the need to focus on recruiting more new members to make up for resignations and inevitable deaths. June Form 27 shows that Branch 59 picked up a net 4 members since January 1, 2016. 20 guests were welcomed through June.

Attendance for the June luncheon was 103, or 66% of active members, well behind our goal of 70% attendance. Hopefully this was a result of summer vacations.

Big Sir Jim Ulam implemented a R.A.M.P program (Recruitment, Activities, Membership and Publicity) to increase membership.

Big Sir Jim Ulam announced that the SIR float decorations for the Fremont 4th of July parade are ready but we still need a pickup with 5th wheel towing capability or a conventional flatbed trailer. Note: a flatbed 4x8 trailer was offered during the luncheon.

The BEC members complemented Jim Ulam and John Skarpelos on the June 7th article In the Tri City Voice about Spencer Christian's presentation to SIR. Jim Ulam used the article to encourage BEC members to identify other great speakers. It was announced that Tim Kawakami of the Mercury News will be the speaker at the July meeting.

Big Sir Jim Ulam showed the large banner (more than 6 foot tall) that he purchased for SIR publicity and recruiting. He recommended that it be placed at various locations such as the Senior Center, Bowling alley, Driving Range, etc. Peter Angelides agreed to take it to the Senior Center and Sammy Lum agreed to take it to the golf Driving Range.

Rob Ingebretson volunteered to accept and coordinate information regarding sick or injured members since the Branch is without a Sunshine Committee Chairman.

Arnold George commented that the average age of SIR members is 78 and many are somewhat hard of hearing. He recommended that we emphasize to our speakers the need to speak louder and slower.

Meeting adjourned at 10:50 am


