SIR Branch 59 BEC Meeting, August 18, 2016

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Sir Hugh Twomey reported that Branch finances are in good shape with a balance of \$4214.09 on August 10th.

Minutes of the June meeting and the Treasurer's report were accepted without change. Big Sir Jim Ulam introduced and welcomed Region 6 Director Ed Benson to the BEC meeting.

Those of us at the BEC meeting expressed great sorrow due to the unexpected death yesterday of Honorary Life Member Sir John Skarpelos.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

<u>Birthdays:</u> Chairman Sammy Lum reported on July and August celebrants. Gordon Thym is the oldest at 93and James Lomax is the youngest at 68.

<u>Membership</u>: Ron Brutvan reported that there are no new members this month. Two guests will attend orientation today. Five new guests today are Joe Lucia, Bob Marshal, Gene Page, Ken Arora and Ronald Pucci. Tony Bruno has resigned; Frank Borghi is going inactive due to health concerns. Bob Fondiller has become active again.

NEW BUSINESS

Big Sir Jim Ulam led off the discussion of Form 27 by commenting that we are doing OK with a plus 4 members year to date. However, he emphasized the need to focus on recruiting more new members to make up for resignations and inevitable deaths. August Form 27 shows that Branch 59 picked up a net 4 members since January 1, 2016. Good news is that 26 guests were welcomed through August including 5 guests today. Member attendance for the August luncheon was 99, or 64% of active members, well behind our goal of 70% attendance. Hopefully this was a result of summer vacations.

Big Sir Jim Ulam commented on the difficulty of finding someone to fill the voids left by John Skarpelos' death. The comment was made that it would take at least 3 persons. Jerry Sabo

had already agreed to take over running the branch web site. Approval to spend \$25 or more, as required, to cover expenses for this purpose was moved, second and passed. Significant effort may be required to recover the many data bases John had for the roster etc. plus his other activities including his outstanding *Pathfinder*.

The large banner purchased for SIR publicity and recruiting has been displayed at the bowling alley, senior center, driving range and library. Big Sir Jim Ulam complimented Arnold George, Sammy Lum and Peter Angelides for their effort in placing the banner.

Big Sir Jim Ulam opened a discussion on the possibility of relocating the monthly luncheon. This was due, in part, to having to cancel the July luncheon when the Newark Pavilion cancelled, on short notice, the SIR luncheon in favor of the Holy Ghost religious activities. Other venues were discussed including The Elks (not available on Thursday) and Swiss Park (very noisy). We have been with the Newark Pavilion for 9 years on a month to month basis without a contract. Some of the advantages of Newark are parking, size, stage, available storage for books, etc. After much discussion a motion was made, passed and second to have a committee meet with Newark Pavilion management on August 30th to discuss contract options that would guarantee a schedule for SIR luncheons.

Rob Ingebretson volunteered to coordinate information regarding sick or injured members since the Branch is without a Sunshine Committee Chairman. He also advised the planning is well underway for our Christmas program.

Sir Ed Benson, Director Region 6, announced that there will be Regional SIR Officer training programs December 5th in Castro Valley. The training will cover all officers, nominating committee chairman. He also commented on the request made earlier during the BEC meeting for volunteers for the Newark School tutors. While such volunteer work is commendable for individuals, solicitation is expressly forbidden by the SIR rules and is not insurable under SIR policies. He strongly recommended that Branch 59 avoid any involvement that could lead to active support of such solicitation activities. Big Sir Jim Ulam tabled further discussion to a later date.

Meeting adjourned at 11:00 am.
