Our Speaker – Frank Price by Little Sir Ted Bresler

We all remember the horrendous damage caused in September in Louisiana and Mississippi by Hurricane Katrina. We may not be aware of the assistance rendered by our local public agencies in assisting the victims of this catastrophe.

One of these agencies is our Alameda County Water District. Between late September and early October the District sent 2 4-person crews to Slidell, LA (a suburb of New Orleans) to restore the considerably damaged water system serving that town by the Bayou Liberty Water Association. The local association could not handle this without considerable outside assistance.

ACWD crews encountered a tremendous amount of damage. The local water association's offices were flooded; they could not get to their meter reading devices. Water service was lacking due to damage to service lines caused by tree uprootings. Debris placed pressure on the water lines, considerably reducing the flow.

District's workers worked from sunrise to sunset for 2-1/2 weeks, uncovering the water system, removing debris, and repairing water service where there were leaks. They cleared 3600 out of 4000 meter boxes so the local Association could start billing customers again. The District spent \$50,000 for its assistance to the beleaguered local residents.

Frank Price, Manager of Distribution Maintenance, Dave Ybarra and Steve Lambrecht, utility workers, will show you what they saw and did to help in Louisiana through a slide presentation, which will be shown by the District's projectionist, Marian Gonzalez.

You will see for yourselves how, working together, we can help the victims of such catastrophes.

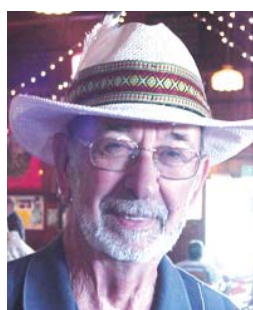
Little Sir Les Addison announced our guest speaker to be the Chief Executive Officer of the Washington Hospital, Ms Nancy Farber.

Sir John Skarpelos announced the Pathfinder deadline as December 23rd.

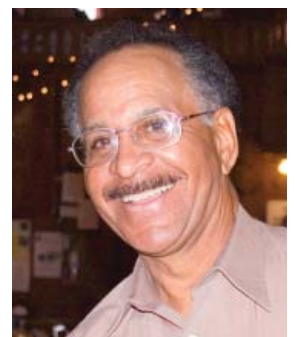
Sir Dave Marymee has several very ill members who need cheering up. See the October Pathfinder.

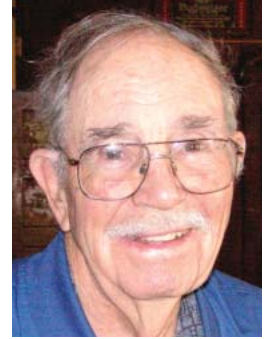

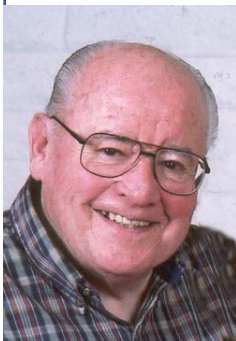
