Edited Excerpts of November 16th Minutes of Allen Sprague

Big Sir Les Addison called the meeting to order at 10:15, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call by Secretary: Officers present: Big Sir Les Addison; Little Sir Ted Bresler, Secretary Allen Sprague, Asst. Secretary Peter Angelides, Treasurer Louis Bufkin; Asst. Treasurer Bobby Ben Snodgrass. Directors present: Don Gillis, Bill Leake, Howard Thompson, Bob Benya, and Art Winkley. Absent: Director Lloyd Anderson.

Treasurer's Report: Sir Louis Bufkin reported that as of October 31, 2006, the ending cash balance was \$5,271.62. Membership was 274 active and 24 inactive members. At the October meeting, there were 205 members (75% of total), 4 guests, and 1 visitor present, for a total of 210. (Full details are in the Form 28 report on file.)

Little Sir Ted Bresler reported: (i) that, in addition to the \$9.79 per head for lunch, there will be an increase in costs incurred at the Newark Pavilion, including rental, which may necessitate an increase of \$1 or \$2 in the fee charged attendee; (ii) Committee members for 2007 are being recruited.

Attendance: Sir Alan Douglas reported that 209 members are expected today (64 excused), plus 5 new members being inducted, and 1 guest.

Social: Sir Tony Zeuli said that tickets for our December holiday party are selling briskly and will sell out quickly. (Big Sir Les led a big hand of applause for retiring chair Tony.)

Golf: Sir Bill Leake reported that there is one more event this year, a cruise to Mexico in December. The January Pathfinder will have complete results of recent tournaments, including Mexico. He reported that dues for 2007 will increase to \$31 (from \$26). (Full details will be in the next Pathfinder.)

Birthdays: Sir Art Winkley reported that 17 of 19 November celebrants are expected today: the most senior is Dan Archer at 88 years, and the youngest is Bill Leake at 61.

Pathfinder: Editor Sir John Skarpelos announced that the next issue will be for January 2007 - deadline late December.

Cybergeezers: Sir Fred Gotthardt reported that the next meeting is the coming Wednesday, November 22nd at 2-4 pm in the Fukaya A Room (and not on the usual Tuesday).

Sunshine: Sir Dave Marymee reported on various members' illnesses and hospitalizations.

New Business—Delinquent Members: Big Sir Les Addison led discussion of the issue

of delinquent members. At present there are 35 members who are not attending meetings in accord with Branch Bylaws which require 5 out of 10 regular meetings being attended. Calls to these members indicated that 2 of these members want to be in the inactive category, 1 is transferring to Palo Alto, and 31 want to continue as members without meeting the attendance requirement (they enjoy the Pathfinder). It was pointed out that each enrolled member (active or inactive) costs the Branch \$4.50 in annual dues. Concern was expressed for bowlers and golf members who might not meet the attendance requirement. Suggestion made to charge noncompliant members \$10 a month for the Pathfinder.

MOTION MSP: Keep the 35 delinquent members for the present but review the matter quarterly, and if any member remains delinquent then eliminate from membership.

New Members: Sir Bill Leake distributed an information sheet to be given to prospective members, explaining the procedure for application, assignment of membership number, and induction.


