He is a qualified DMAT(Disaster Medical Assistance Team) CA-6 Menlo Park team member. He was one of the first called to New Orleans during and after Katrina. He was a medic in the Army 4 years and the Navy 3 years. He is a disaster Response and Mitigation Specialist. American Heart Association Certified Instructor. Medic First Aid Certified Instructor - CPR/AED First Aid Basic and

Advanced MERT(Medical Emergency Response Team). This goes on for awhile suffice it to say this man know his business and is here to help.

In the time it takes you to read this newsletter, sudden cardiac arrest will have claimed another



victim. Statistics show that more than 200,000 Americans die of sudden cardiac arrest every year. Up to 50,000 of these deaths could have been prevented if someone had initiated the Cardiac Chain of Survival, and an **automated external defibrillator (AED)** had been available for immediate use at the time of the emergency. Our speaker will provide an overview of this subject.

#### **Edited Excerpts of January 18th Minutes of Allen Sprague**

Big Sir Ted Bresler called the meeting to order at 10:15, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call by Secretary: All officers present: Big Sir Ted Bresler; Little Sir Dick Holley, Secretary Allen Sprague, Asst. Secretary Peter Angelides, Treasurer Louis Bufkin; Asst. Treasurer Bobby Ben Snodgrass. All directors present: Les Addison, Bob Benya, Lloyd Anderson, Don Gillis, Robert Ingebretson, and Tom Sullivan. Absent: None.

The Minutes for the November 16th meeting of ExCom, were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Sir Louis Bufkin reported that as of November 30, 2006, the ending cash balance was \$7,992.23. Membership was 272 active and 26 inactive members. At the November 16th meeting there were 205 members (75% of total), and 4 guests present (209 total). A report on the December 21st Christmas Party reported \$3,442.00 income, and \$2953.52 expenses, for a net balance of \$488.46. As of January 5, 2007, the ending balance was \$6095.14. Membership was 272 active and 25 inactive. At the December 21st Christmas the Sweetheart event in May. Party there were 95 members, and 85 guests for a total of 180. (Full details are in the Form 28 reports on file.) The reports were accepted.





#### **A LIVING WILL**




His wife, Annemarie, got up, unplugged the TV and threw out all of his beer.


