Sir Allen Sprague Meeting Minutes

Big Sir Ted Bresler called the meeting to order at 10:10 am, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call by Secretary: Officers Present: Big Sir Ted Bresler, Little Sir Richard Holley, Secretary Allen Sprague, Assistant Secretary Peter Angelides, Assistant Treasurer Bobby Ben Snodgrass, Officers Absent: Treasurer Louis Bufkin. Treasurer's Report: Assistant Treasurer Bobby Ben Snodgrass presented the report from Treasurer Louis Bufkin. As of August 2, 2007 the ending cash balance was \$3,307.64, and membership was 270 active members and 20 inactive members. At the July 19th luncheon there were 211 members (78% of total membership), 4 guests, 2 visitors for a total attendance of 217. Program: Little Sir Dick Holley confirmed that our speaker will be "Lil" Arnerich, former Oakland Oaks baseball player, a "stem-winder" speaker, who will hand out free tickets to Oakland A's games, and also several baseballs will be the meeting of August 6th (this meeting awarded to lucky Sirs. 
