Our Speaker - Jess Strange by Little Sir Don Gillis



Our speaker for January is Jess Strange. The title of her presentation is "Knowledge is Key: Know Your Medicare Rights."

Jess Strange is a community education advocate for legal assistance for seniors and the Health Insurance

Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP). This presentation explains consumer protections for Medicare beneficiaries by reviewing appeal rights under traditional Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans. The presentation will also provide important contact information on advocacy organizations, agencies and web sites.

In her advocacy role, Jess Strange visits senior centers, senior residences and other community centers throughout Alameda County to give presentations about Medicare, Advance Health Care Directives, Scams & Frauds and other issues which affect seniors. She received a B.A. in Spanish and a B.A. in International studies from Miami University in Ohio in 2005.

Sir Allen Sprague November Meeting Minutes

Big Sir Ted Bresler called the meeting to order at 10:15am and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call by Secretary: Officers present: Big Sir Ted Bresler, Little Sir Richard Holley, Secretary Allen Sprague, Assistant Secretary Peter Angelides, Treasurer Louis Bufkin, and Assistant Treasurer Bobby Ben Snodgrass. Officers absent: None. Directors present: Bob Benya, and Robert Ingebretson. Directors absent: Les Addison, Lloyd Anderson, Don Gillis, and Tom Sullivan.

The Minutes for the November 15th meeting of Executive Committee were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Sir Louis Bufkin reported that as of November 1, 2007 the ending cash balance was \$5,959.29, and membership was 270 active members and 19 inactive members. At the October 18th luncheon there were 197 members (73% of total membership), 6 guests and 1 visitor for a total attendance of 204. (Full details are in the Form 28 report on file).

Program: Little Sir Richard Holley confirmed that today's speaker is Julius Murphy. Captain Murphy is an ordained officer in the Salvation Army, and will be discussing the programs and ministries of the Salvation Army in Fremont, Newark, and Union Citv.

Attendance: Sir Hugh Twomey reported that the expected attendance for today's luncheon is 203.

Membership: Sir Ron Brutvan placed Jess J. Jacinto and Neil (Tony) Russell up for membership. It was moved, seconded, and passed to approve Jess J. Jacinto and Neil (Tony) Russell as new members. Sir Ron also submitted the names of two members to be dropped for lack of attendance contra Rule 100: Robert Wanser (#61), and Wilson Williams (#132). It was moved, seconded, and passed to approve the recommended deletion from membership, provided these members fail to attend today's meeting.

Birthdays: Sir Art Winkley reported that 11 members with November birthdays are expected today. The most senior celebrant is Sir William Delucchi at 84 and the youngest is Sir Bill Leake at 62.

Bowling: Sir Frank Cordova reported on an upcoming tournament in early December (details are in the Pathfinder).


