## Strikes and Spares by Jerry Sabo



Twelve of the bowlers from Branches 6 and 59 went to Sonoma on February 7th. We don't have the actual results in yet, but there were several good scores. In a handicap tournament such as this one, there are usually two divisions: A bowler in the A Division= average >180 (approx.) whereas B Division= average <180. When a bowler bowls his average, the series score is 690. In

singles, we had series scores of: Lew Heffron (Br. 6)-718, Don Henry-736, Chuck Pereira (Br. 6)-719, Jerry Sabo-747, and Roger Wallin-712. Doubles score: Frank Cordova-731, Lew Heffron-771, Don Henry-799, Darrell Jewell-720, Nat Lord-742, Jerry Sabo-690, and Roger Wallin-776. With those scores, singles winners should be Don and Jerry, and doubles winners should be partners Nat and Darrell, and possibly Roger and Jerry, but who knows. There are also awards for total series scores from singles and doubles.

Only four of us attended the Livermore Tournament. Jerry had a pretty good series in singles, and Don Henry did well in doubles. This was a 220 handicap tournament where a 660 series would be average. Jerry had a 745 and Don, a 724. We did have a good trip in the rain.


