During our April meeting, the Seagate Wireless storage device was demonstrated. This device is capable of streaming movies to three iPad, iPhone, Android tables, or some Kindle devices simultaneously. Three different HD movies—also music, photos etc. could also be accessed on up to eight devices. Some discussion of Blu-Ray ripping software took place. The Intuos 5 tablet by Wacom was also demonstrated as a replacement for a mouse, and for drawing, photo editing and so forth. Finally, we revisited the use of Dragon Naturally Speaking—voice recognition software and the use of software to create on-line pdf forms, and software that converts a pdf file to a MS Word document.

Our June meeting was devoted to Mac OSX computers, some comparisons to Windows 8, and a bit of time with the iPad. We will most likely resume this discussion at our July meeting.

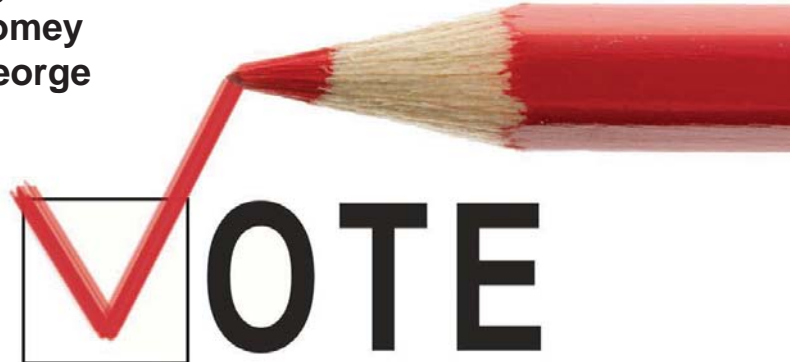
