Tim Kawakami is a sports columnist for the San Jose Mercury News. In addition to his print column, he maintains a blog, communicates on Twitter, and has a podcast series. Kawakami attended Northwestern University, where he got his start in sportswriting with the The Daily Northwestern. While continuing to cover boxing, he began covering UCLA Bruins men's basketball in their national title season in 1994-95. He became the beat writer for the Los Angeles Lakers in 1998-99, covering the basketball team through the Shaquille O'Neal-Kobe Bryant era. Kawakami was interested in becoming a columnist, but the Times filled their opening with T. J. Simers. Kawakami left for the Mercury in the mid-2000s, writing a Page 2 column and later a regular column.

SIR Branch 59 BEC Meeting, October 20, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 10:02 am by Big Sir Jim Ulam; the flag salute and roll call of Officers and Directors was conducted. All Officers and Directors were present.

Treasurer's Report: Sir Hugh Twomey reported that Branch finances are in good shape with a cash balance of \$3708.10 on October 10th. Minutes of the June meeting and the Treasurer's report were accepted without change.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Birthdays: Chairman Sammy Lum reported on the October celebrants. John Ockes is the oldest at 89 and Jim Proffitt is the youngest at 69.

Membership: Ron Brutvan reported that Jerry Ford, Bob Marshal, Jim Cunningham, Ken Arora and Ronald Pucci will become new members today. The two guests that are scheduled to attend orientation today are Ronald Matusak and Gene Page. He reported on the results of notifying members, by mail, of their required attendance (e.g. 3 consecutive unexcused absences, etc.) under Rule 100. Thus, 4 members went inactive and 4 members were terminated.

NEW BUSINESS

Big Sir Jim Ulam led off the discussion of Form 27 by commenting that the good news is the 5 new members who are joining today. However, he again emphasized the need to focus on recruiting more new members to make up for resignations and inevitable deaths.

Ed Guthrie reported that member attendance for the September luncheon was 92, or 59% of active members, well behind our goal of 70% attendance. There were 35 excused and 29 unexcused absences.

Rob Ingebretson stated that some branches require members pay for lunch for an unexcused absence. Sometimes there has been a problem in making sure that new members have a place to sit at luncheons. Sponsors need to address this responsibility in addition to helping them get acquainted during the social hour.

Rob Ingebretson advised that planning is well underway for our Christmas program. The BEC authorized Rob to spend what he considers reasonable for Christmas entertainment. Jerry Sabo requested that members look at the Branch 59 website (http://www.sirbranch59.org/) and provide to him items and photos for the site.

Meeting adjourned at 11:07 am.




