SIR Branch 59 BEC Minutes, November 17, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 10:05 am by Big Sir Jim Ulam; the flag salute and roll call of Officers and Directors was conducted. All Officers and Directors were present except for Nat Lord and George Perry.

Treasurer's Report: Sir Hugh Twomey reported that Branch finances are in good shape with a cash balance of \$3656.66 on November 17, 2016.

Minutes of the October meeting and the Treasurer's report were approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Birthdays: Sammy Lum reported on the November celebrants. William Delucchi is the oldest at 93 and Bill Pruner is the youngest at 69.

Membership: Ron Brutvan reported that Ronald Matuszak, S. Gene Page and Joe Lucia will become new members today. Ron raised the question of how long a person could remain inactive, but further discussion was tabled to the next BEC meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Big Sir Jim Ulam led off the discussion of Form 27 by commenting that the good news is the 5 new members joined last month. However, we lost 8 and are now at a net minus 1 for the year. Good news is that we will have 3 new members today. He again emphasized the need to focus on recruiting more new members.

Ed Guthrie reported that member attendance for the October luncheon was 113, or 74% of active members, exceeding our goal of 70% attendance.

Art Winkley noted that we will have 7 members reach the age of 90 in 2017. Walt Oden, Tom Sherba, Art Winkley, Joe Markovich, Fred

Gotthardt, Stanley Lewis, and John Ockes. He offered to buy each a lunch for their birthday. Art also agreed to take over the position of Sunshine Chairman.

It was also noted that Forrest Lusher will be 100 in February.

The *Pathfinder* is now being mailed to 48 members each month. The current cost of printing, mailing and handling the *Pathfinder* is \$1.18 each. At least 18 persons receiving a hard copy have Email addresses. After much discussion, the following motion was passed:

"Members who have Email and wish to continue to receive a printed copy of the Pathfinder by USPS mail the charge for this service will be \$12 per year to cover printing, mailing and handling expenses."

This new requirement will be announced in the January *Pathfinder* and will be implemented for the February issue.

Meeting adjourned at 10:55 am.
