Big Sir Harvey's Thoughts

As most of you may agree with me, the fourth quarter of the year is probably the most important and busiest quarter for any SIR branch, and our branch is no exception. Important, because it is when the branch really pushes it to realize and surpass the goals set at the beginning of the year.

And busy, because of the various ongoing activities in the implementation process as well as those activities in the production process. Let me explain and be more specific. First regarding goals. In January of this year, our total membership was 153 members. That meant that the goal our branch needed to meet by year's end is eight new members (5%). As of September 2018, our branch was lagging behind in our recruitment effort by -1%(-3 lost) or 150 members, which means that just to meet our minimum goal of 161 members; we still need 11 more members. Help us meet our goal and put a silver lining to this particular issue.

Notice I keep emphasizing minimum goal. The other goal is Luncheon Attendance. Here, our goal is to keep the percentage of total membership attendance at our monthly luncheons at a minimum of 70%. As of our last luncheon, our branch is precisely at 71%. So from the standpoint of performance, or, how the State would categorize us as a viable and growing branch, I would say our combined performance to date has been less than satisfactory. There are only three more full months to go. This is crunch time folks. We need more members. So in these last three months, I challenge each of you to extend yourselves just that much further so that collectively, we can not only meet our goals, but exceed them.

I would like to once again remind everyone that our Annual Ladies Christmas Luncheon is rapidly approaching Tickets will be on sale, and table seating reserved, at the October and November luncheons.

Bill Quirk—Assemblyman

William J. "Bill" Quirk is an American politician currently serving in the California State Assembly. He is a Democrat representing the 20th Assembly District, which encompasses

the southern East Bay of the San Francisco Bay Area.

Bill has an undergraduate degree in engineering and applied physics and a PhD in Astrophysics, both from Columbia University.

After a postdoctoral fellowship at CalTech, he went to NASA Goddard, where he developed one of the first 3-dimensional global models of the earth's climate. His pioneering paper showing a feedback between the biosphere and the climate is still referenced today.

From 2004-2012 Bill served as a Hayward City Council member, where he led the revival of the City's Downtown and fought hard to keep the City's budget balanced during the 2008 economic downturn.

He was elected to the Assembly in 2012. He is the only scientist serving in the California Legislature and continues to use his expertise on energy and climate change to help shape legislation that will better the lives of all Californians.

They will report back at the next BEC so that

decisions can be made at the November BEC regarding 2019 food service.

NEW BUSINESS

SIR President Derek Southern sent out a request for feedback on proposals for "The Future of SIR." Big Sir Harvey is distributing the document and collecting input from officers and directors to meet the October 30 deadline for Branch 59 input.

Next year Rob Ingebretson is stepping down from his long run as Social Chairman. We expect it will take several members to replace him. Big Sir Harvey distributed a list of 30 members who have been born in 1940 or later as potential candidates for positions as officers and committee chairman. It was noted that of the 35 new members that have joined since 2015 only 4 have become involved in leadership roles.

Sir Kasey Warner outlined the Elk Club's proposal for our use of their two Bocce courts. Both courts could be available for two hours for \$150 and would accommodate up to 16 players. Sign up sheets will be distributed at lunch to help determine interest.

Big Sir Harvey suggested we consider the possibility of an outdoor Bar-BQ next May or June.

Big Sir Harvey asked everyone to bring a guest to the October 17th meeting.

Sir Bowlers are required to be USBC members to participate in any of the major tournaments that are available. Cost for USBC Membership is currently \$25 per year, but if you are just wanting to try out our SIR Branch 59 League, called Monday Sirs then just show up at Cloverleaf Bowl between 12:30 and 12:45 so we can begin bowling at 1:00 (on Mondays). In other words, the \$25 is

only required if you decide to join our league. If you have a USBC Membership from another league then you don't have to pay a second time.

Our league began in early September and continues until the following September, but Sir Bowlers are not assigned to teams so there is no penalty for missing bowling, and you can join our league any time during the year. Weekly bowling cost is \$15 for three games. Cloverleaf offers seniors another 10 free games per month so you can practice Monday-Friday before 5:00.

So should you want to give bowling a try.

- 1) Show up on Monday (Holidays excluded)
- 2) Let Sir Frankie Cordova or Sir Art Winkley know that you would like to bowl.
- 3) Select a bowling ball and get bowling shoes unless you have your own.
- 4) Get a lane assignment
- 5) Practice for about 10 minutes then start bowling.
- 6) Hints and lessons by SIR bowlers are free

Should you decide you want to join our group, there is no obligation to bowl in any tournaments, but there are many tournaments available during the year with 100% handicap. So if you average is 100, and if the highest bowler in the tournament has an average of 230, then you get and extra 130 pins handicap for each game.
