Micky Ganitch—SURVIVOR

A Master Mason since 1969, Mickey Ganitch has been a member of Orinda's Masonic Lodge since 1992, and currently serves as its chaplain. He is also one of the few Pearl Harbor survivors remaining in America.

An Ohio farm boy who grew up driving a Ford Model T, he recalls his parents giving away a significant portion of the corn, potatoes and fruit they grew to hungry relatives during the Great Depression. He continues their goodness, helping with his church's pantry and serving Thanksgiving meals. He's been an usher for 46 years.

His hero's journey began before the Pearl attack even launched. "Germany was taking over so many countries. Japan was already expanding. I saw the handwriting on the wall," he said. He enlisted Jan. 16, 1941, joining the flagship of America's Pacific Fleet - the USS Pennsylvania. "We always had an admiral aboard."

That ship would have been one of Japan's first targets - save for serendipity. Propeller issues had forced the ship into dry dock. "We weren't in our normal place," he said.

Ganitch saw it all from the crow's nest. While readying for morning football practice ahead of a big game against the USS Arizona, the Pennsylvania's guns thundered. Clad in everything but helmet and spikes, he clambered up his ladder. One bomb missed him by just 45 feet.

He and two other Pearl survivors recently celebrated the return of Mount Diablo's beacon Oct. 22. The light was a guide for planes and ships from the time it was turned on by Charles Lindbergh in 1928 until the day after the Pearl attack. Lit each Dec. 7 since 1964 at the request of Pacific Fleet Admiral Nimitz, the beacon will shine again.

Treasurer's Report and BEC Minutes:

Sir Hugh Twomey reported that Branch finances are in good shape with a cash balance of \$4188.91 on November 21, 2018. The Treasurer's report and Minutes for the October meeting were approved. The 2019 Budget was approved which incorporates the inactive member change addressed in New Business below.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

## Membership:

Sir Carl Nordling reported that there will be no new members today. However, two second time guests are scheduled today. Three first time guests are also expected.

## **Attendance**

Sir Ed Guthrie reported the expected lunch attendance is 104.

## November Birthdays

Sir Lloyd Anderson is the oldest at 88 and Sir Bil Pruner is the youngest at 71.

## OLD BUSINESS

There was a decision reached regarding a disagreement over how an activity was being run. After an extended discussion at the BEC last month and consultation with the Area Governor and Region Director the following was decided:

Each Activity Chairman will make the rules for his activity. There can be no discrimination against an individual member's participation, but all participants must comply with the rules the Activity Chairman has established.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

There will be no "Inactive Member" status

after October 30, 2018. The reason for this is that Sons In Retirement, Inc. General Liability Insurance does not insure "inactive members" when they attend SIR sponsored activities. Members are required to attend at least 5 of the past 10 luncheons (Rule 100). Current inactive members will have to contact the Membership Chairman regarding their intention to return to member status before the January luncheon to remain a member of SIR. The BEC can, on a case by case basis, make exceptions for issues such as health.

Big Sir Harvey proposed, with BEC approval, that 2019 Little Sir Richard Henry take on the R.A.M.P. coordinator responsibilities. He also directed Little Sir Victor Okumura to help Sirs in need of transportation to luncheons.

Next year Sir Rob Ingebretson is stepping down from his long run as Social Chairman. We expect it will take several members to replace him.

Sir Howard Elz was approved to replace Sir Kasey Warner as Activities Chairman and R.A.M.P. Activities Chairman. Sir Larry Jet was approved to be a Director in 2019. Sir Jerry Halligan was approved as a Director and Sir Rob Ingebretson was approved as Assistant Secretary.

Sir Rob Ingebretson discussed the December 19<sup>th</sup> Christmas lunch plans and urged everyone to sign up ASAP. He also made a motion, which was approved, to have leis for potential members and new members attending luncheons. The purpose was to identify new comers so that current members would engage and welcome them.

Big Sir Harvey emphasized the pressing need to recruit new members and asked everyone to bring a guest to the January meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 10:58 am.

The Membership Committee will briefly explain what the SIR organization is all about. Since this is his first visit he will be asked to fill out a Membership Application which entitles him to a complimentary lunch. As his sponsor, have a seat for him at a lunch table, and introduce him to other members of Branch 59.

The Membership Chairman will contact the guest one or two weeks prior to his second visit to confirm that he is still interested in joining SIR and if so he will be asked to arrive by 11:00 am. He will be given a comprehensive orientation briefing. The Orientation Chairman will answer any questions he may have. He will receive a \$15.00 reduced fee lunch ticket at this visit. Have a seat for him at a lunch table, and introduce him to other members of Branch 59.

# The State SIR Manual has been updated.

Effective January 2019 there are changes pertaining to Membership and Attendance that you should be aware of.

## **Membership:**

<u>Inactive Member</u>: The "inactive member" status has been deleted from the SIR Manual as of October 30, 2018.

This means that we are all a SIR Member.

The terms INACTIVE & ACTIVE will no longer be used.

The reason for this change is that Sons In Retirement, Inc. General Liability Insurance does not insure "inactive members" at attendance at any SIR sponsored activity.

## **Attendance Requirement-Rule 100:**

With this change, the January Branch 59 Attendance Record has been updated and will reflect a fresh start for all members.

As a Member of Branch 59 you are required to attend at least five out of ten Monthly Luncheon Meetings, or you will be subject to termination from SIR Branch 59 membership.

If a member is in violation of the Attendance Rule 100, the member shall be notified by the Membership Committee by telephone and/or in writing.

The Branch Executive Committee may grant a member attendance relief who is unable to attend luncheon meetings due to a prolonged illness, acting as a caregiver to a family member or companion, or for an extended absence from the branch locale.

A member that is granted attendance relief is still considered a member and subject to Branch rules.

If you cannot attend a scheduled meeting, or if you are sponsoring a potential member, call the Branch Attendance Chairman one week before the meeting so that we can insure that we have the proper amount of food and adequate seating arrangements.
