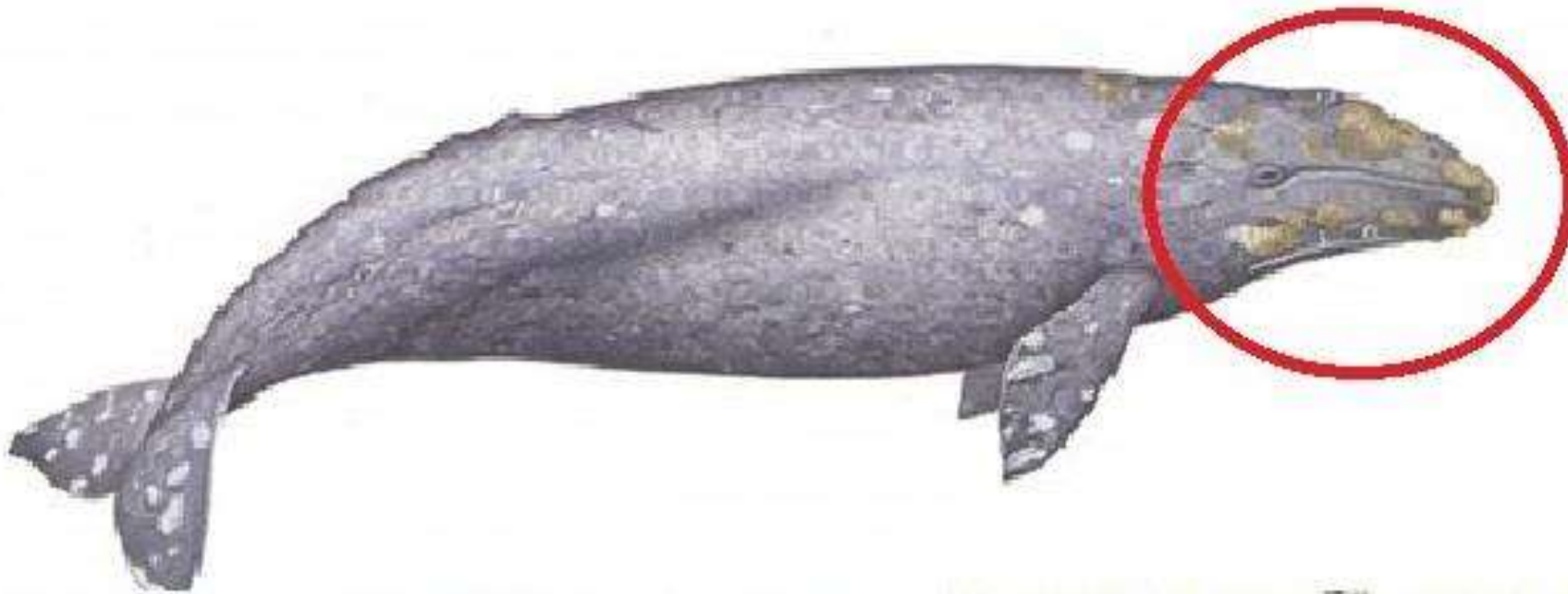

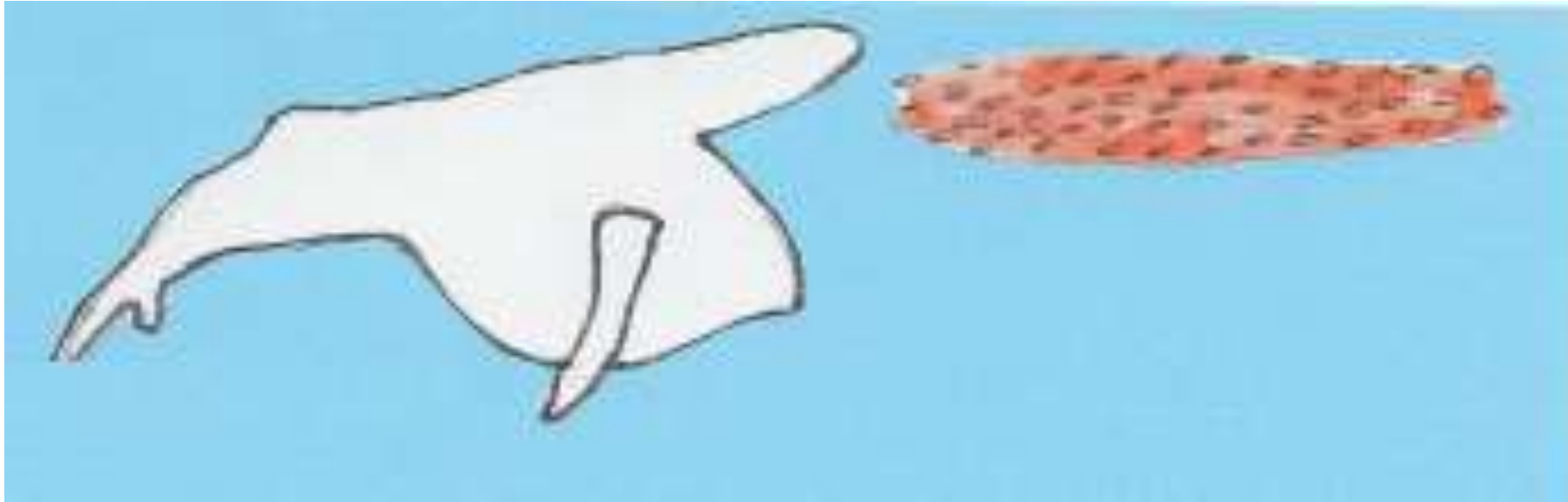

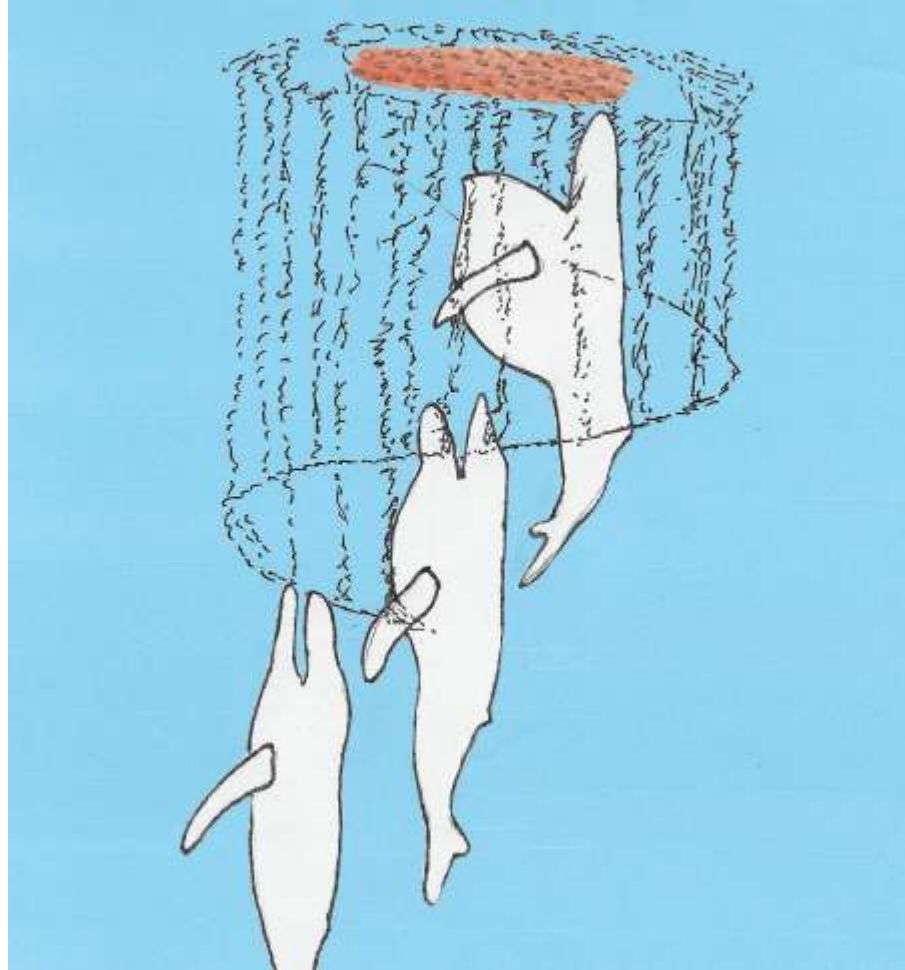

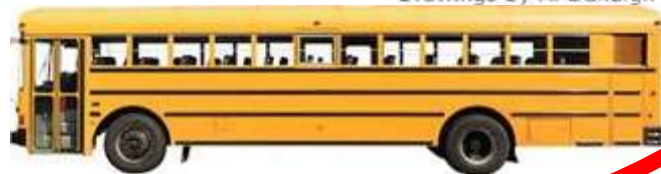

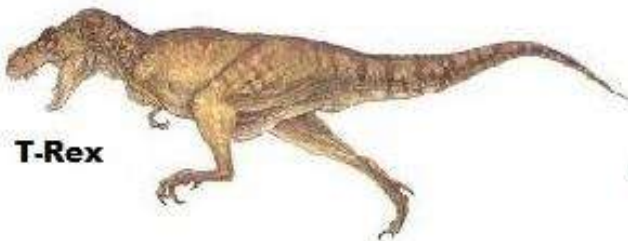

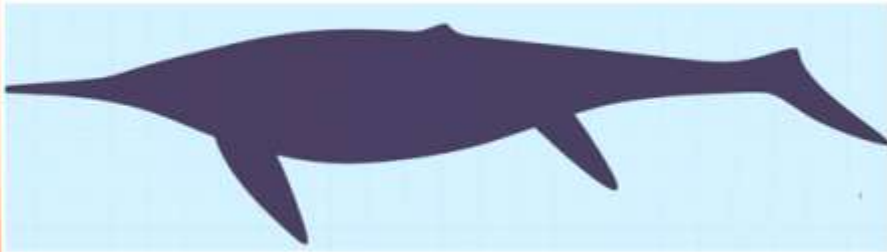

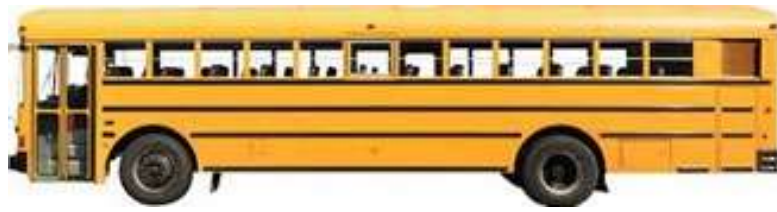

See Whales - When, Where and How

- Take a whale watching boat out of San Francisco, Half Moon Bay, Santa Cruz, Moss Landing or Monterey.

Search the internet for “Whale Watching Boats”.

- As for whale watching boats: Almost anytime of year is good.

(Call ahead to see how good the whale watching is for your time.)

- **Gray Whales:** December through May
- **Humpback Whales:** April through October
- **Blue Whales:** June through September
- Shore viewing of **Gray Whales:** April to mid-May
