

Oct. 8, 2017 Fleet Week Air Show Cruise (1 day): Watch the 2017 Air Show from San Francisco Bay on a buffet lunch cruise aboard the iconic San Francisco Belle. Complementary coffee, tea, soft drinks, and sparkling wine are included. Price is \$188 per person, includes bus transfer from the Capitol VTA parking lot in San Jose. Bus leaves promptly at noon.

May 25 - June 9, 2018 - Niagara Falls, Eastern Canada & Cruise to Boston: This trip visits the historic Eastern Canadian cities of Toronto, Ottawa, Quebec City, and Montreal, includes an overnight at Niagara Falls, and concludes with a Holland America cruise down the St. Lawrence River to Boston, MA. The cost will begin at about \$3700 without air fare for an inside cabin on the cruise. Trip presentation – 2 PM, Wed., Sep. 27th at Mama Mia's, 200 E Hamilton, Campbell. A 10% discount is available for those attending the presentation.
