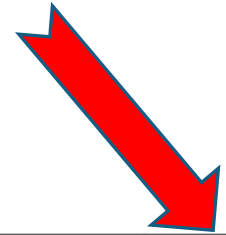

Today's Speaker

[John Lehman](#) is a world-class musicologist/historian John Lehman. John knows more about the origins of all specific recorded songs in the USA since 1890 than probably anyone in the world. His presentation is a fun program that he calls "Who Sang It" where he plays a snippet of a popular or movie-theme song dating to as far back as he feels the audience might be familiar and asks all people collectively at a table to identify such things as who sang it, what movie it was from, etc. There is competition between tables as he presents approximately 20 songs. Thereafter he shares insight into the history of the songs and singers.

Due to a surplus from 2018 dues are temporarily dropped to **\$15** per branch member for 2019 (yeah!).

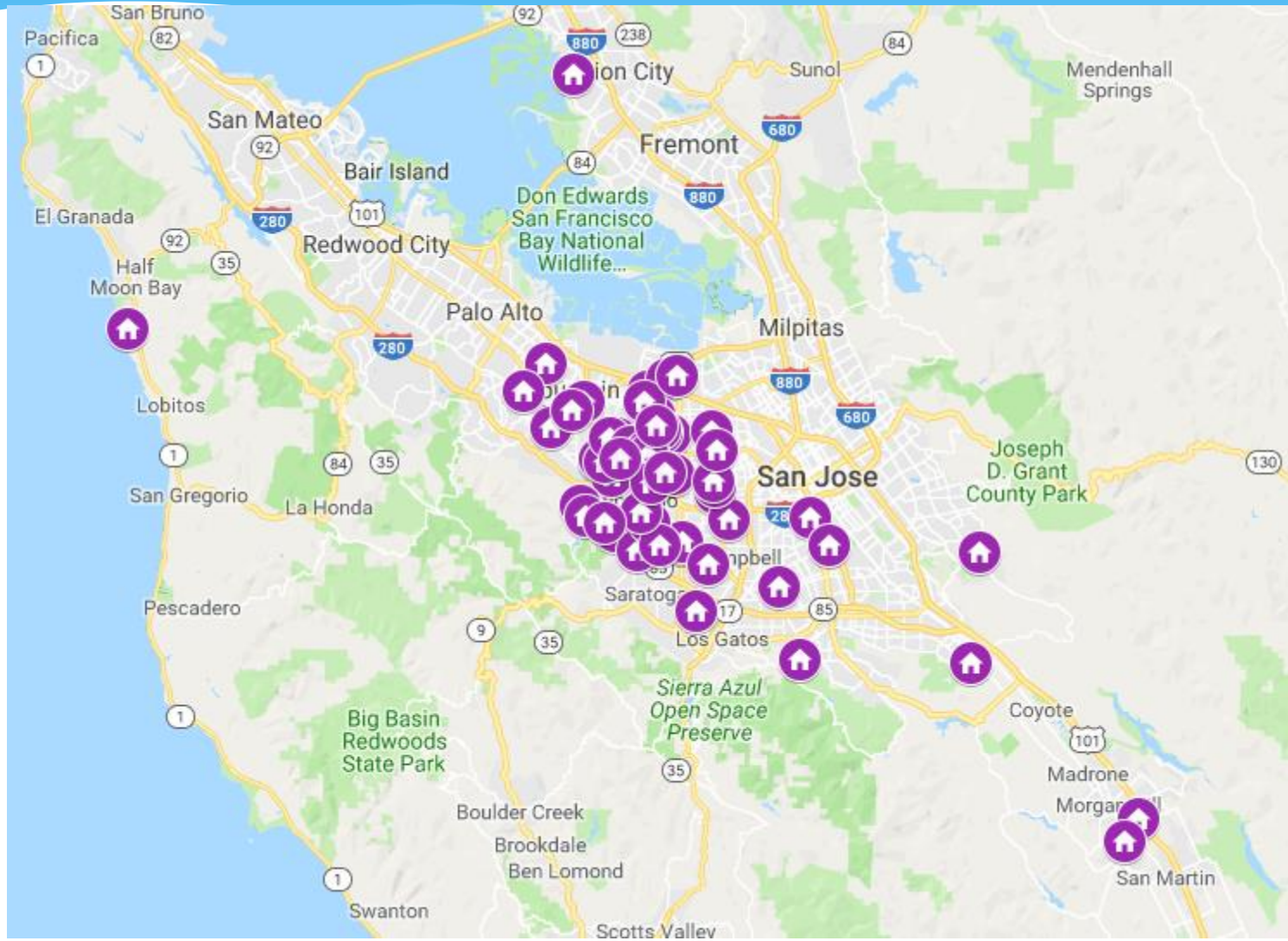

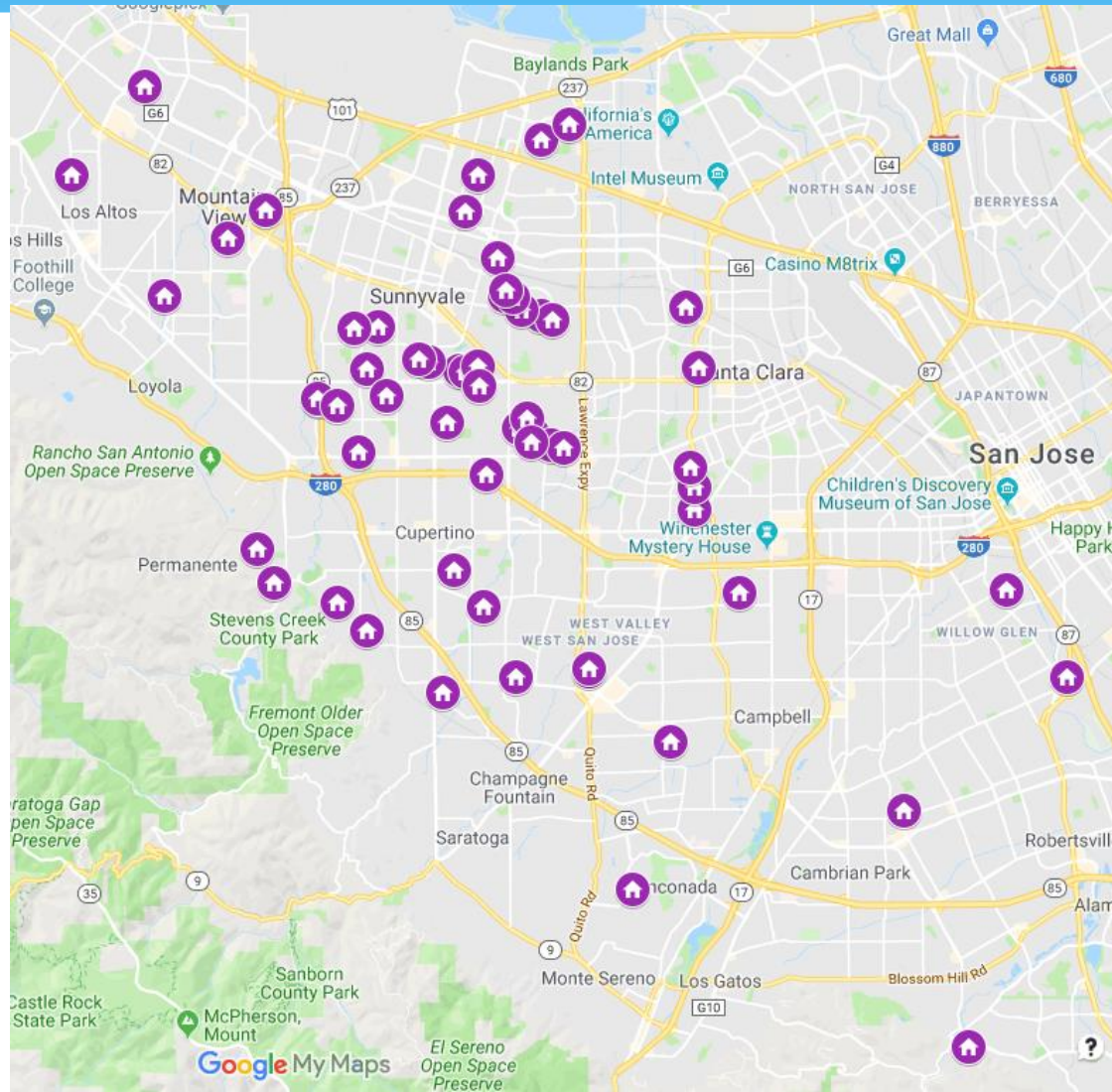
