Six members of the Jolly Hookers assisted 16 California Department of Fish and Game wardens, several other fisherman, and professional guides to gather Kokanee eggs from the Little Truckee River.

The process was set up by F&G with a section blocked off about 100 feet wide, with volunteers herding the fish into large nets and hand held nets, then to be placed in barrels for F&G to select healthy males and females for sperm and egg gathering.

Millions of eggs were gathered, for trucking to special holding tanks. When they become fingerlings, they will be moved to target lakes and streams.

This annual gathering is the only source for F&G to maintain the Kokanee population in California.
