## SIR Branch 95 Golf

It looks like we are finally going to have weather that will make playing golf enjoyable. I wanted to take this time to cover one of the new rules that is causing some discussion among players.

~Flag stick in or out when putting ~The rule was changed to speed up play. You now have three choices when putting from the green. One, take the flagstick out before your putt. Two, have the flagstick tended (though if the tending party does not remove the flagstick and your putted ball strikes it, it is a two-shot penalty). Three, leave the flagstick in and no penalty if the putted ball strikes the flagstick.

#### ~Pros

- Studies show that you will make more putts leaving the flagstick in the hole. The flagstick narrows your focus on the center of the target.
- Longer lag putts will usually keep the ball close to the hole if the flagstick it hit. This is true also of downhill putts of most lengths.

### ~Cons

Your eyes aren't used to it and it is a change of thinking. The flagstick is a narrow target, if you putt more aggressively because the flagstick is in and you do not hit the flagstick your result may be worse. You may be bothered by the flag or its shadow.

### ~Variables

• The science is clear for fiberglass flagsticks, not so clear using metal flagsticks. If the flagstick is moving in the wind or doesn't sit well in the bottom of the cup, you might want to take it out.


