

SIR STATE GOLF NEWSLETTER

2025 is here and your State Golf Committee has put together an exciting program of tournaments for you. While the final schedule is still in progress, the following events have been finalized:

NAPA—the “Spring Fling” at Chardonnay and Eagle Vines on April 23-24

FAIRFIELD—“Fun in Fairfield” at Paradise Valley and Rancho Solano on May 28-29

RENO—“Return to Reno-Again” at Lakeridge and Toiyabe on June 24-25. Nugget Hotel at a great rate (\$104/night including all taxes and fees)

TEAM SCRAMBLE CHAMPIONSHIP—at Hiddenbrooke, and it will be played over 2 days (Aug.6-7). This is the “ABCD” Scramble tournament

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP—October 2 at The Reserve at Spanos Park. Limited to 112 players. 7 Flights.

MONTEREY—The “Week in Monterey” will be highlighted by a 2 day competition at BlackHorse and Bayonet. This will be a 4 man, 2 Best Ball 36 hole tournament, but there will be both Team and Individual winners each day. There will be at least one other official tournament during that week, detail being worked on.

We are still working on a Fresno event and another East Bay event which will be announced later.

NEW COMPETITIONS THIS YEAR

We have added two new ANNUAL competitions this year, one for Individuals and one for Teams.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP—There will be several flights and we will post each players lowest 3 net scores. Every Tournament where an Individual can

post his score is an opportunity to post low scores. Scrambles will not be eligible.

TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP—We will be holding several 4 man 2 Best Ball tournaments during the year. The lowest 3 net scores for each TEAM will be posted and prizes will be awarded. The only catch is that you must use the players from your roster of up to 6 players. Any 4 of the Team members may play for a score to be counted. Players may only play on one team unless specifically released and approved by the Chairman. Select your teams as soon as possible.

A player on a team roster not being used at a Tournament may play and compete on another Team for the daily prizes, but he cannot play on more than 1 Team posting a score in this competition.

EXAMPLE: George is on Team X, but they are using 4 other players. George may play in the Tournament, but the Team he plays for that day may NOT post their score in this competition. They would be eligible for all other daily prizes.

At the end of the year, prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each of these competitions. There is **NO cost to enter** (Individuals are automatically entered), but Teams must register and list all their players no later than the start of the SECOND tournament they are playing. Simply e-mail a list to the State Golf Chairman.

Roster changes must be approved by the State Golf Chairman.
