## Walking/Hiking Group Proposed:





#### News Of The Day From State

- If you use Medicaid with a supplemental policy or you use a different health insurance, you may have an opportunity to receive up to \$130 a year by being active in SIR.
- We are working with an organization named Grouper. Because health insurers recognize the importance of social and physical activity, they pay their insureds through Grouper to encourage these activities.
- Essentially, if your insurance has a contract with Grouper, you can qualify for this monetary benefit through your SIR activity. On signing up with Grouper, you receive a check for \$50 Thereafter, you can receive a \$20 quarterly check simply by being active in SIR. Note: This is an annual benefit.
- SIR also benefits with a one-time payment and referrals from the Grouper network.
- Look for more information about this opportunity from your BEC in the near future.
