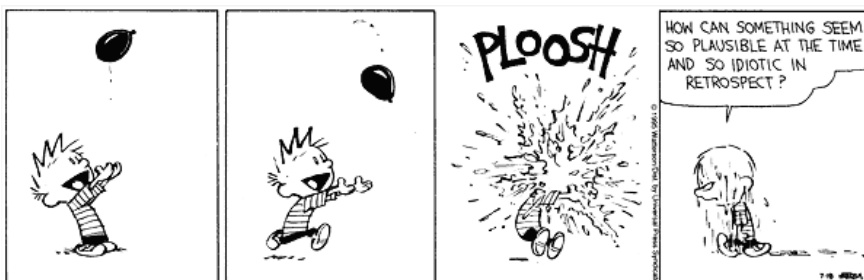
TIME FOR SIR!!
